for Christ the Master, saved them as a good One.**

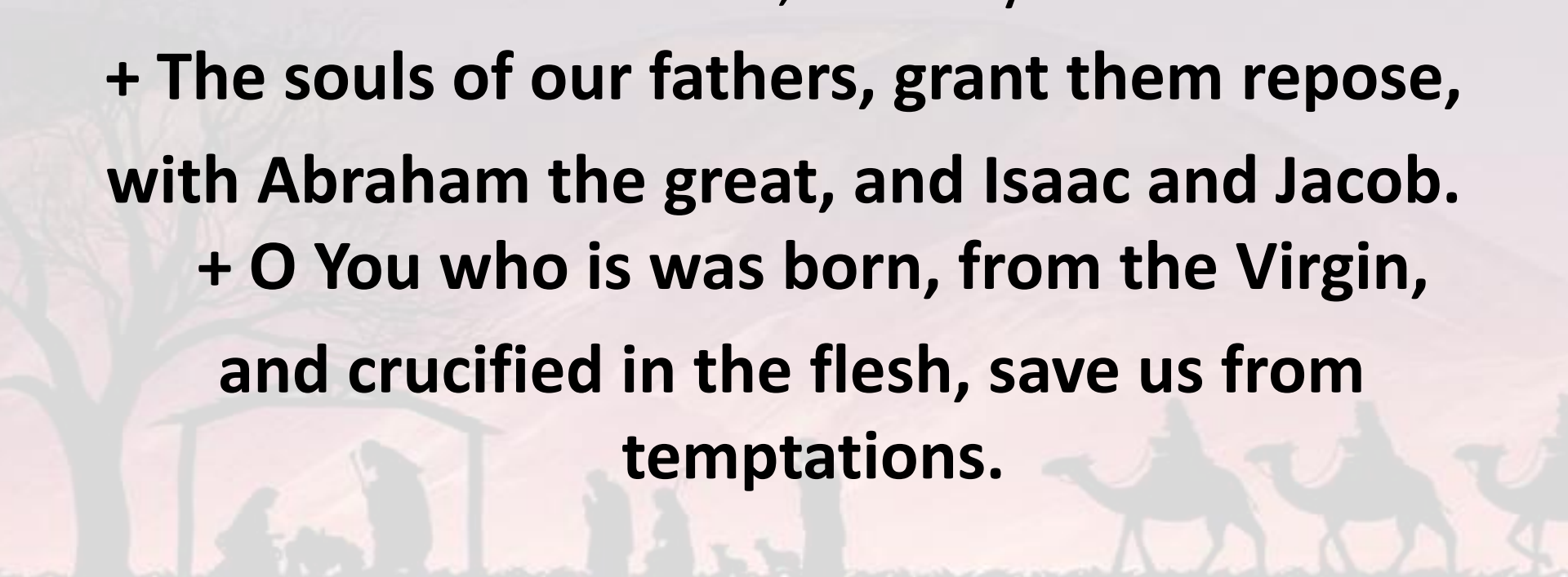
Psali Adam – Sunday (Nativity Paramone)
