# *The prayer of Manasseh*

Therefore, You, O Lord of the righteous, have not given repentance for the righteous, for Abraham and Isaac and Jacob, who had not sinned against You, but you have given repentance for me, the sinner.

# *The prayer of Manasseh*

“ O Lord Almighty, God of our fathers, of Abraham and Isaac and Jacob, and of their righteous seed. You Who have made heaven and earth with all their adornment.

You Who have bound the sea by the word of your command, You Who have shut the deep, and sealed it with your fearsome and glorious Name.
