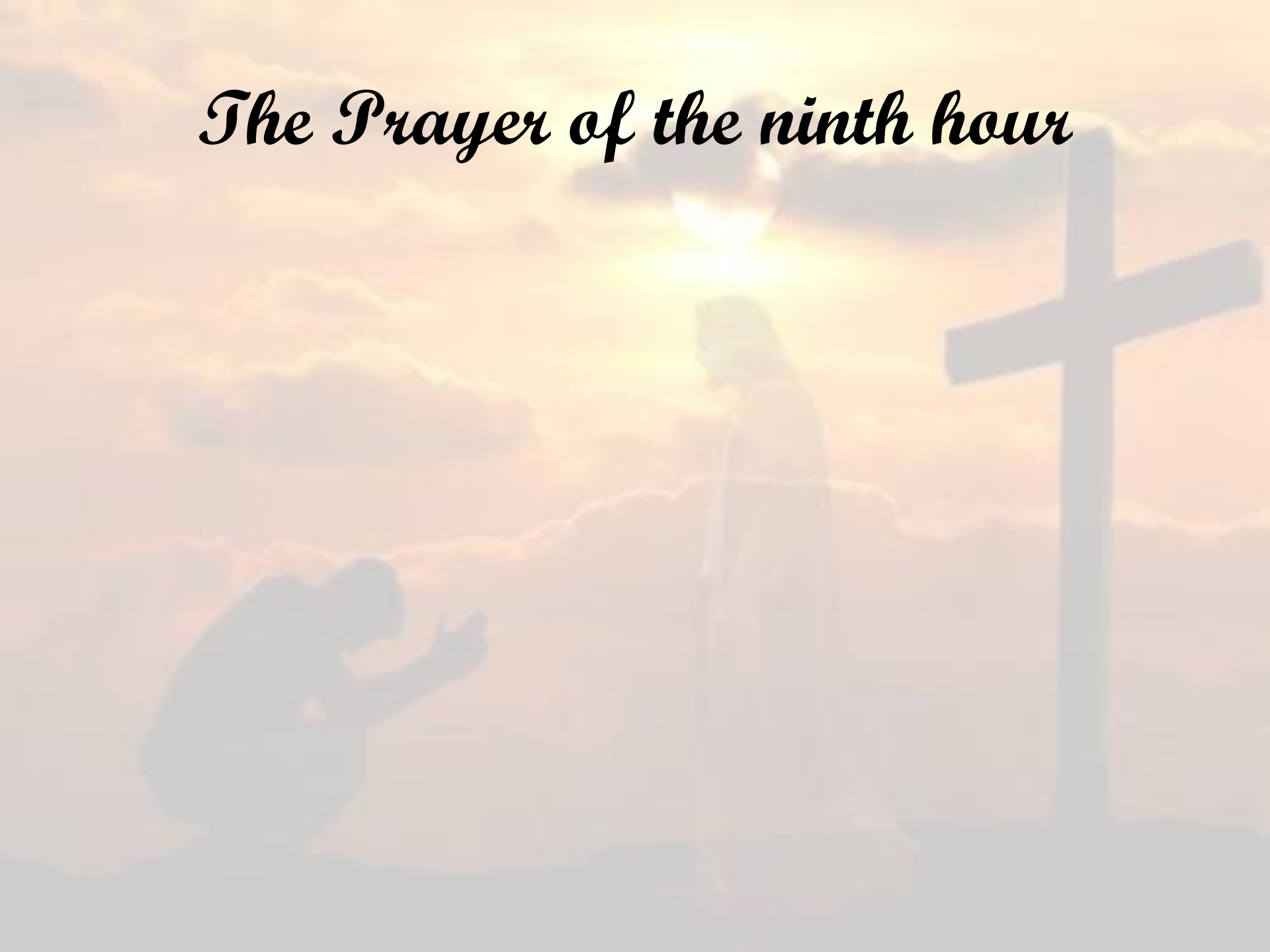

The Prayer of Nehemiah (Nehemiah 1:4-16)

“I pray, LORD God of heaven, O great and awesome God, You who keep Your covenant and mercy with those who love You and observe Your commandments, please let Your ear be attentive and Your eyes open, that You may hear the prayer of Your servant which I pray before You now, day and night, for the children of Israel Your servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel which we have sinned against You. Both my father’s house and I have sinned. We have acted very corruptly against You, and have not kept the commandments, the statutes, nor the ordinances which You commanded Your servant Moses. Remember, I pray, the word that You commanded Your servant Moses, saying, ‘If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations

Unction of the sick - 1st Prayer

Unction of the sick - 1st Prayer

Unction of the sick - 1st Prayer

O You who raised the son of the widow and the daughter of the centurion from death when, ordered to rise, and Who raised Lazarus four days after his death with divine authority, raise Your servants from the death of sin and If You ordered their rise for another period, Grant them help and assistance to please You all the days of their life.

Through Your blood, which was shed for our salvation, with which You purchased us because You are our hope, we Your servants, through the intercession of the Virgin Mother of God and the prayers of all the saints. For glory, honor and worship are due to You O Father, Son and Holy Spirit, now, forever and at all times and unto the age of all ages. Amen.
