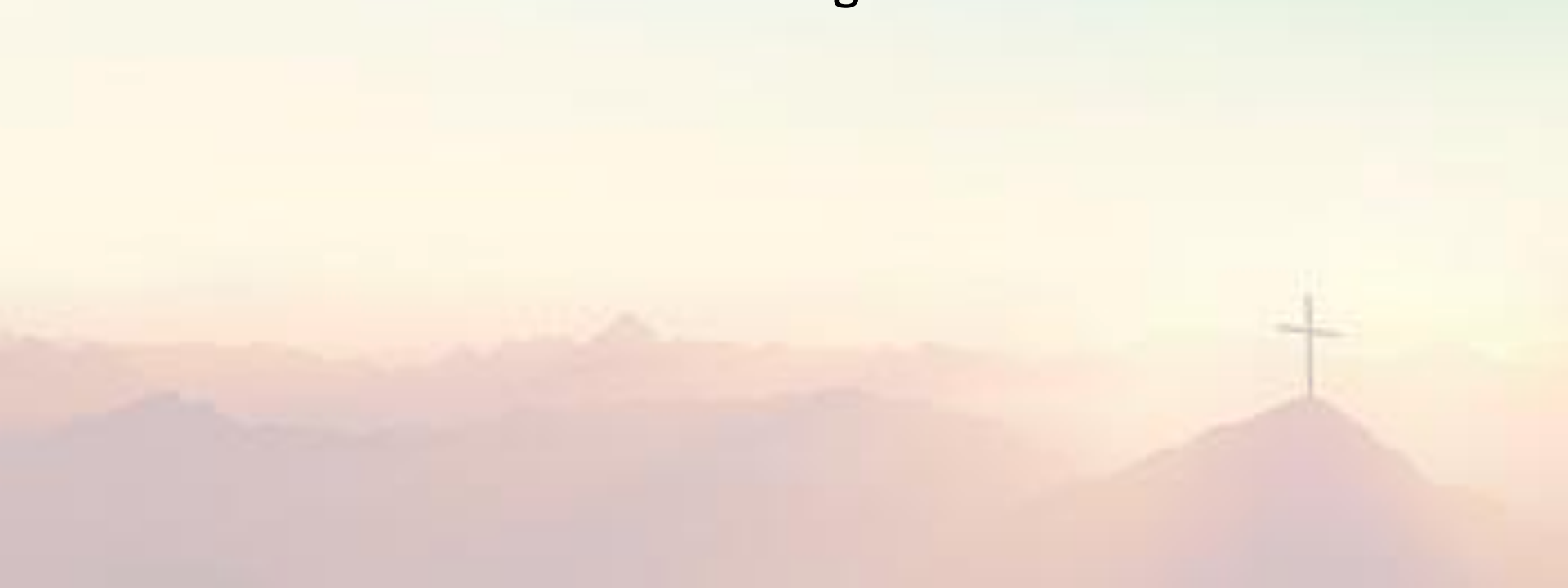
# Prayer of Sirach (Sirach 36:1-19)
